- Monitor and control compressors, fans, and furnace gas content using CO₂ sampling equipment.

- Inspect and maintain racks, fixtures, and castings for alignment, straightness, and overall quality using templates.
- Conduct routine CO2 and boron trifluoride line checks, documenting inspection results.
